"I think polo's the finest thing that a horse and a man can do together."

Known for his brazen roles and taciturn portrayals of cowboys, law-enforcement agents and military men; Tommy Lee Jones passions are not confined solely within the industry that has seen him grow into an award-winning actor.

The 72-year-old has also spent over two decades consumed with his love for the sport of polo. The Harvard graduate has built world-class polo fields, practice fields, horse farm and stables in Florida which he listed for sale in 2015, a ranch dubbed as San Saba in Texas; and a 74-acre equestrian facility in Buenos Aires.

Jones holds a 2-goal handicap and has fielded two separate teams and played with his ex-spouse and six professional polo players. "Polo brings out some really raw, inspirational emotions," and continued "The mechanics involved in being able to hit a ball that small from the back of a horse, is quite staggering. If you consider you're aboard an animal running at 30 mph, your time and vision are being stretched to the absolute limit in order to be able to hit that ball with

any amount of accuracy. It took me many years to get the technique right, and I'm still a long way from perfect," he smiles.

Such was his love for the game that talked about his time in the building and maintaining his Hollywood career being an interference to his time on the field. "I look back now and realise that the movie business has hurt my polo. To realise your full potential, you have to play all year round, and that's just never been possible for me," he adds.

1. When and how were you introduced to polo?

I was around 4 or 5 years old living on our farm in Cordoba.

My father, he played professional polo as well.

3. How many times a week do you train? Describe your typical training day.

I try to do something every day. I go to the gym, school my horses and play practices or some penalty shots!

4. What are your polo pre-game preparations that are unique to you?

My pre-game preparations are usually in the morning, a warm-up in the gym and then go to the stables to see the horses and end up with a good stretch!

5. What are your top 5 interests aside from polo?

Hmm good question, but honestly, I think about my horses all day – the best way to get them fit and how to improve my skills day by day, and I try to be with my family the rest of my free time.

6. Welcome back after a short trip with Ghantoot last year and this season you are joining Habtoor Polo. Tell us about the team this year.

Thank you very much, and yes last year I was part of Ghantoot which is a great club. I'm grateful for the opportunity they gave me. This year I'll be defending the colours of Habtoor with Tommy Beresford, Hugo Lewis and Mohammed, I think it's a complete team with a good defense and attack!

7. I heard you brought your horses in the UAE, tell us a bit more about them? Any favorites?

I own 7 horses that are in the UAE right now — 6 flew from the UK and 1 from Argentina. I think it's a good string as some had played in the Argentina Open and the high-goal tournament in England. My two favourites are Ranchera and Copada.

8. Congratulations on being awarded a 9-goal handicap, how does it feel?

Thanks, they moved me up last year. Now I have little bit more pressure to play well every game and to make fewer mistakes as possible in order to maintain the new handicap level.

9. Do you consider your current handicap status your greatest achievement? If not, what do you consider to be your greatest triumph to date?

I try not to consider my handicap. I do my best to improve every day, help the team get the best results and that my teammates play at their highest level.

10. You must be very proud of the results your team achieved this year. What are your plans for the Argentine Opens in 2019?

I'm very happy with the amazing season we had, it was the first season playing together with Las Monjitas. I think reaching the final of the Argentine Open is quite an achievement. We aim to get better mounted and try to win the Argentine Open 2019 season.

11. You've had a look at the teams playing at the Julius Baer Gold Cup. What do you think of the lineup and are there any teams you look forward to playing against?

Every year it seems to be more challenging with such powerful teams. This year, the team that I mostly look forward to competing against is UAE Polo.

12. What are you looking forward to during your stay in Dubai?

I've always had a great experience in Dubai, I think the city has lots of fun things to do and enjoy the polo season!

13. What advice would you give to aspiring polo players

My advise would be to play polo to have fun, it's a sport in which you can spend lot of time with horses, a truly a noble animal. One must also recognize that you are not playing on a machine, these are animals that you need take good care of and work hard! And with as much passion you have for this game, you must also spend lots of quality time together with your family.

Al Habtoor Polo Resort and Club plays host to several equestrian disciplines such as Polo, Riding, Show Jumping, Dressage, and Equitation wherein a beautiful display of horses amaze its spectators. To some, it is easy to generalise these mares and stallions as a horse is a horse right? However, if we look closely, equines have certain features that make them suitable for a particular line of equestrian sport.



Lesson Horses

Lesson horses set itself apart from polo ponies as they have qualities more suited to young riders who are still learning to ride. These horses are more 'forgiving' in terms of temperament and generally not highly reactive giving its riders a safe way to learn. Soundness and flexibility are also evident as these horses are ridden several times daily by different individuals.

Lesson horses are trained to deal with the commotion that usually occurs in group lessons – i.e. getting students to tack up and mount their horses. Vices are not present such as biting, bolting, kicking other horses and weaving inside the stall when bored. Horses need to be dependable and trustworthy as they will keep their good behaviour even if paired with an inexperienced rider.

Given the above, older horses make for good lesson horses as experience typically comes with age.



Polo Ponies

The true players in the Sport of Kings are not a specific breed but a type of horse that has a combination of build, speed, intelligence, agility and a "mind for the game" brought about skilled training from at least the age of three.

The estimated ideal height of a polo horse is 15-16 hands (a hand is four inches) and weighs between a thousand to eleven hundred pounds. The manes are clipped as close to their necks as possible. The top part of their tails (dock) are sometimes trimmed with tails plaited and taped before a game to avoid the hair getting caught in reigns and mallets.

Polo ponies are trained to respond to pressure in the bit and along the neck as reins are held in one hand of the player and the other holds a



mallet. They are also trained in dressage footwork to improve agility and control, collection and extension, flying changes, rein-back (walking backwards) and even piaffes are common as the ponies run, stop and turn quickly.

Showjumping 4 Dressage Horses

Horses used on both disciplines call for an equine that has reached superior athleticism, and they carry similarities in terms of conformation.



Horses used for show jumping are strong and athletic. It is certain that most horses are capable of jumping but breeding plays a big part in producing strong competitors. Warmbloods sourced from Germany, Holland and Belgium are considered the best lines of show jumpers. Typical physical traits include well-developed withers or saddle area and long necks that are set fairly high to assist with balance over the top of a fence.

Dressage horses are considered the ballerinas of equine sport. They have the capability to display power and balance whilst maintaining suppleness and ease as they conduct difficult movements. They have more of a forward reach from the shoulder – outward rather than upward. A dressage horse also has a high neck, but shorter and more upright than a jumper.

The Man Behind the Art

DPGC: What does "being creative" mean to you?

I like to refer to the process of creativity as Irving Stone did: 'The agony and the ecstasy' it is an extremely painful process but it brings a sense of bliss like no other.

DPGC: Can you tell me a bit about your background, i.e. where you are from, what did you study at school, etc.

I grew up in Cape Town, South Africa. From a young age my parents supported my interest in sculpture. I went to study architecture and obtained a Bachelor's degree from the Nelson Mandela Metropolitan University, after my studies I decided to focus solely on art.

DPGC: How did you start making art? And what or who inspired you to become an equestrian artist?

After a short period teaching at my previous school, I became fascinated with horses that surrounded the campus. I decided then to pursue equestrian artworks and push myself into a new subject. Emaar purchased my first life size horse, It was a passion project that I undertook alone so to have sold it before the bronze casting was a great honour.

DPGC: Describe a real-life situation that inspired you.

Recently I attended a charcoal drawing workshop in Tuscany. The people I met as well as the teacher gave me great inspiration to not only keep pursuing my expressive means of creating art, but also taught me a discipline in drawing I had never had.

DPGC: What's integral to the work of being an equestrian artist?

With any subject, but especially equestrian, it is vital to know the subject intimately. The different species of horse are as intriguing as the different human cultures. They all have their own characters and there is an inherit way in which the individual animals move.

DPGC: What is your most important artist tool? Is there something you can't live without in your studio?

Surprisingly music is an integral part of my process. I will often stop work to change a song or setup a more intense mood with the music. Sculpture is such a physically and mentally demanding activity that it takes many outside influences to keep me focused and inspired.

DPGC: Is there a piece of artwork you are most proud of? Why?

I feel every artwork is a part of me, I equate it to scars on your body. Each one leaves its mark and you judge the work based on the time and place in which it was created. However, I do feel that my first life size horse sculpture gave me an incredible sense of pride. It was completely sculpture from scratch by myself using my two hands. 1,5 tons of clay was used to create the original and I know that every part of it was done by my hand. It still has me in awe.

DPGC: What is unique about your art, process and the way you want people to interact with it?

In this day of consumerism and the short lived nature of products, I feel my work (all in bronze) hails back to an age of patrons and artists. Bronze work lasts thousands of years and its a medium which is not that well known outside the art world. I aim to make every work of art the absolute highest quality and cast by the most reputable foundries. The style nods to the classical but also retains a raw and grounded expression.

DPGC: What kind of creative patterns, routines or rituals do you have?

I work very methodically and a lot of the process begins in the studio, the work begin in making sure the studio space is setup in such a way as to create as little distraction and inconvenience as possible. If everything goes to plan the work flows easily regardless of scale. I do not like to obsess over works for months, if a piece is not working I will put it aside and begin again. Much of what I do relies on spontaneity and beautiful accidents.






